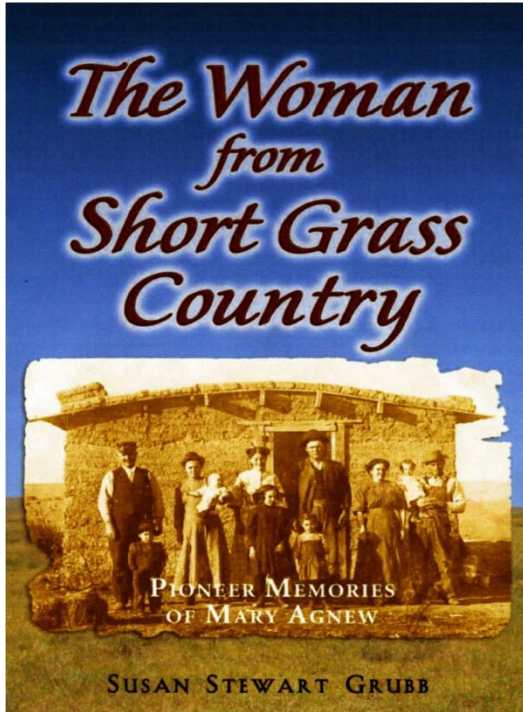


New Release!
